

Mount Gravatt High School In Catchment Enrolment Proof of Residence

Mount Gravatt High School is an enrolment managed high school. If you reside within our catchment area you will need to provide proof of residence as indicated in our School's Enrolment Management Plan (excerpt below).

Parents or legal guardians who wish to enrol their child at Mount Gravatt High School will need to demonstrate that the student's principal place of residence is within the catchment area. Current proof of residency at the address indicated on your application form can be provided by way of **one of each** of the following:

 ONE PRIMARY SOURCE - a current lease agreement, or rates notice, or unconditional contract of sale in the parent's/legal guardian's name;

AND

• ONE SECONDARY SOURCE - a current utility bill (e.g. electricity, gas, water), showing this same address and parent's/legal guardian's name.

If the Principal is not satisfied that the documentation provided by an applicant demonstrates adequately that the address stated is the student's principal place of residence, then the Principal may request further sources of proof of residence.

Please ensure you attach both documents listed above to your Expression of Interest Form. Please note that applications submitted without the abovementioned proof of residence will not be processed.
