MUSIC EDGE

The Music EDGE program offered at MGH is a selective entry program, open to students who have been accepted for Year 7 in 2027.

Mount Gravatt High (MGH) offers unique opportunities for students who have been accepted into the Music EDGE program. Students are enriched through teaching and learning experiences, and enjoy additional extension opportunities. Music EDGE students focus on developing practical performance skills, both individually and as part of a group, as well as exploring composition processes and software. Students in Music EDGE interact with other high-achieving peers who are able to think at the same depth and pace in a supportive, low-risk, high-challenge learning environment.

Year 7 Music EDGE is a one (1) year course. In Term 1, students develop practical skills on both keyboard and guitar. Term 2 sees students begin work on a performance project that leads to a live or virtual class performance in Term 3. The year culminates with students learning to create their own original compositions using notation software. A multi-disciplinary excursion to QPAC backstage, QAG and/or City Hall concert also helps support and extend students' learning.

Please note that students can be in, and are encouraged to apply for, both Music EDGE and our IM Excellence programs (see separate information and processes) if suitable. These are complementary programs that work together to extend students musically. All students will also participate in the general IM program if relevant to their instrument to further support their musical growth. MGH also offers a Vocal Tuition program as an option to further support and develop singers' skills.

Expressing your interest in Music EDGE

Entry into the Music EDGE cohort is based on merit, and candidates undertake an application process to be considered for this program.

Expressions of interest for Music EDGE are open with enrolments and will close on Friday 5 June 2026. Families will be notified of the outcome on Friday 26 June 2026. Suitable late applications will be placed onto a waiting list and considered should a place become available.
