<b>Business</b>	1 x 128-page A4 exercise book. USB. Pencil case containing pens, 2B pencils, ruler, eraser, glue, scissors, colouring pencils and a sharpener.	
<b>Dance</b>	1 x 48-page exercise book. 1x 64-page scrapbook. Dance apparel black tights and black singlets for girls. Black shorts and black singlet or t-shirt for boys. Students are expected to rehearse both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props that are not available through the department. At times, students may be required to attend performances and workshops at an extra cost. Class work will be performed at school events e.g. Parade, Dance Night etc.	
<b>Drama</b>	1 x 48-page exercise book  <i>Students are expected to rehearse both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props. At times, students may be required to attend outside performances and workshops and an extra cost will apply. Additional out-of-hours rehearsals may occur in preparation for performance evenings.</i>	
<b>Engineering and Construction Skills</b>	A4 notebook, HB pencil with eraser.  Each student will be required to wear the personal protective equipment (PPE). This can be purchased from the uniform shop. PPE consists of safety glasses and an apron. This is compulsory. Students may from time to time be required to source specific materials which enhances their work. This is developed through the guidance of the classroom teacher.	
<b>English</b>	2 x 64-page A4 exercise books, USB, pencil case containing standard equipment, dictionary and thesaurus.	
<b>Introduction to Essential English</b>	2 x 64-page A4 exercise books, USB, pencil case with standard equipment and dictionary.	
<b>Fitness and Recreation</b>	Fitness and Recreation has a theory component and students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. <i>Complete school sports uniform, including sport hat, to be worn for each practical lesson.</i> This uniform is outlined in the school uniform guide. Sick/injured students will need a note from home. Fees for outside venues may be incurred.	
<b>Furnishing Skills</b>	A4 notebook, HB pencil with eraser  Each student will be required to wear the personal protective equipment. This can be purchased from the uniform shop. PPE consists of safety glasses and an apron. Students may from time to time be required to source materials to enhance their work through the guidance of the teacher.	

<b>Health and Physical Education</b>	Health and Physical Education has a theory component and students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. <i>Complete school sports uniform, including sport hat, to be worn for each practical lesson.</i> This uniform is outlined in the school uniform guide. Sick/injured students will need a note from home. Fees for outside venues may be incurred.
<b>Health Education (Extension)</b>	Students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. Homework and assignments will be set and it is mandatory for students to have access to their school OneDrive. Fees for outside venues may be incurred.
<b>Home Economics</b>	Ring Binder, blue and red pens, coloured pencils, highlighters, ruler, paperscissors, glue stick. Cookery: 2 x tea towels, carry home container, own cookery ingredients depending upon weekly requirements, slice trays, basic cake tins.
<b>Humanities 1</b>	2 x 128-page A4 exercise book, USB, pencil case containing pens, 2B pencils, ruler, eraser, glue, scissors, colouring pencils and a sharpener.
<b>Humanities 2</b>	2 x 128-page A4 exercise book, USB, pencil case containing pens, 2B pencils, ruler, eraser, glue, scissors, colouring pencils and a sharpener.
<b>Industrial Graphics and Design</b>	A4 note book, HB pencil with an eraser and a ruler. School laptop device for homework.
<b>Digital Technologies</b>	A positive attitude centered on engaging in all tasks presented, focusing on meeting and overcoming all challenges. All students should have a USB for backup purposes.
<b>Introduction to Mathematics - Essential</b>	1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator (E.g. CASIO fx-82AU PLUS II) which can be purchased from the school uniform shop.
<b>Introduction to Mathematics - General</b>	1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator (E.g. CASIO fx-82AU PLUS II) which can be purchased from the school uniform shop.
<b>Introduction to Mathematics - Methods</b>	1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator (E.g. CASIO fx-82AU PLUS II) which can be purchased from the school uniform shop. (Note: It will be mandatory for students to purchase a Casio fx-CG20AU or Casio fx-GC50AU calculator (approx. \$220) for Years 11 and 12 if they continue to study Mathematical Methods. This calculator could be purchased for Year 10 if students are confident that they will continue their studies in Years 11 & 12).
<b>Introduction to Mathematics – Specialist</b>	1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator (E.g. CASIO fx-82AU PLUS II) which can be purchased from the school uniform shop. (Note: It will be mandatory for students to purchase a Casio fx-CG20AU or Casio fx-GC50AU calculator (approx. \$220) for Years 11 and 12 if they continue to study Mathematical Methods. This calculator could be purchased for Year 10 if students are confident that they will continue their studies in Years 11 & 12).
<b>Japanese</b>	1 x A4 binder notebook, 1 x ring-binder folder and plastic sleeves, headphones or ear buds.

<b>Media</b>	1 x 48-page A4 exercise book and 8GB USB. Students are expected to film and edit both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props for any productions.
<b>Music</b>	1 x 96-page music exercise book (including manuscript), USB (minimum 8GB), headphones, adapter for connecting phone to laptop display folder (20 pages minimum).
<b>Physical Education (Extension)</b>	Physical Education extension has a theory component and students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. <i>Complete school sports uniform, including sport hat, to be worn for each practical lesson.</i> This uniform is outlined in the school uniform guide. Sick/injured students will need a note from home. Fees for outside venues may be incurred.
<b>All Science Elective Subjects</b>	2 x 128-page A4 exercise books, scientific calculator. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 x A4 64-page 5mm graph book</li> </ul> Note: calculators purchased for use in Math classes in senior years are suitable for all senior science subjects.
<b>Visual Art</b>	1 x HB pencils, 1 x soft eraser, 1 x A4 Visual Art Diary, 1x USB, headphones or ear buds. <i>Excursions to art galleries may incur a small fee for transport and admission.</i>
