| <p><b>Business</b></p>   | <p>A4 exercise book, general stationery items.</p>  |   |
| <p><b>Creative Design and Technology</b></p>   | <p>HB pencil with eraser, safety glasses and blue cotton drill apron (available from the Uniform Shop). Students may from time to time be required to source specific materials which enhances their work.</p> <p><b>SAFE WORKING AND DRESSING HABITS WILL BE ENCOURAGED AT ALL TIMES.</b></p>  |   |
| <p><b>Dance</b></p>  | <p>Dance apparel – black tights and black singlet for girls and black shorts and black singlet for boys.</p> <p>Exercise book or A4 lecture pad for notes.</p> <p>Students are expected to rehearse both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props that are not available through the department.</p> <p>At times, students may be required to attend outside performances and workshops at an extra cost. Class work will be performed at school events e.g., Parade, PAN, Dance Night (Term 4) etc.</p> |   |
| <p><b>Design and Graphics</b></p>  | <p>1 x A4 notebook, HB pencil with eraser, ruler</p> <p>School laptop device for homework.</p>  |   |
| <p><b>Digital Technologies</b></p>   | <p>A positive attitude centred on engaging in all tasks presented, focussing on meeting and overcoming all challenges. All students should have a USB for backup purposes.</p>  |   |
| <p><b>Drama</b></p>  | <p>1 x 48-page exercise book and 1 x 64-page A4 Scrapbook. Students are expected to rehearse both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props. At times, students may be required to attend outside performances or workshops and an extra cost will apply. Additional out-of-hours rehearsals may occur in preparation of performance evenings.</p>  |   |
| <p><b>English</b></p>  | <p>2 x 64-page A4 exercise books, A4 plastic sleeves and general stationery items. Students should have a dictionary/thesaurus for home reference.</p>  |   |
| <p><b>Food Technology &amp; Design</b></p>   | <p>Students should have a named bag large enough to carry cooked items. Students will be required to supply their own cookery ingredients and a non-stick brownie slice tray and a round spring form pan 25 cm. Students selecting textiles will be given a list of requirements once their project has been selected.</p>  |   |

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| <b>Health and Physical Education</b>                               | Health and Physical Education has a theory component and students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. <i>Complete school sports uniform, including sport hat, to be worn for each practical lesson.</i> This uniform is outlined in the school uniform guide. Sick/injured students will need a note from home.  |
| <b>Health and Physical Education (Extension)</b>                   | Health and Physical Education Extension has a theory component and students will require a notebook, writing equipment and a laptop. <i>Complete school sports uniform, including sport hat, to be worn for each practical lesson.</i> This uniform is outlined in the school uniform guide. Sick/injured students will need a note from home. Fees for outside venues may be incurred.   |
| <b>Humanities - Geography/History</b>                              | A4 exercise book, ring-binder folder and plastic pocket sleeves for holding worksheets and materials and general stationery items.  |
| <b>Industrial Design and Technology</b>                            | 1 x A4 note book, 1 x HB pencil with eraser, safety glasses and blue cotton drill apron (available from the Uniform Shop). <b>SAFE WORKING AND DRESSING HABITS WILL BE ENCOURAGED AT ALL TIMES.</b>   |
| <b>Japanese</b>  | 1 x 96-page A4 note book, 1 x A4 display folders, headphones/ear buds   |
| <b>Mathematics</b>   | 2 x 240-page A4 exercise books, ruler, pens/pencils, protractor, compass and a calculator and a <b>CASIO fx-82AU PLUS II</b> scientific calculator. (Calculators can be purchased from the Uniform Shop.)   |
| <b>Introduction To Essential Mathematics (Semester 1 Year 10)</b>  | 1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens/pencils, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator e.g. Casio fx-82AU PLUS II which can be purchased from the school Uniform Shop.  |
| <b>Introduction To General Mathematics (Semester 1 Year 10)</b>    | 1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens/pencils, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator e.g. Casio fx-82AU PLUS II or which can be purchased from the school Uniform Shop.   |
| <b>Introduction To Mathematical Methods (Semester 1 Year 10)</b>   | 1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens/pencils, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator e.g. Casio fx-82AU PLUS II, which can be purchased from the school Uniform Shop.<br><br>(Note: It will be mandatory for students to purchase a Casio fx-CG20AU or fx-CG50AU calculator (approx. \$220) for Years 11 and 12 if they continue to study Mathematical Methods. This calculator could be purchased for Year 10 if students are confident that they will continue their studies in Years 11 and 12).                       |
| <b>Introduction To Specialist Mathematics (Semester 1 Year 10)</b> | Students need to purchase 1 x 256-page A4 exercise book, ruler, pens/pencils, protractor, compass and a calculator. The minimum requirement for this course is a scientific calculator e.g. Casio fx-82AU PLUS II, which can be purchased from the school Uniform Shop. (Note: It will be mandatory for students to purchase a Casio fx-CG20AU or fx-CG50AU calculator (approx. \$220), for Years 11 and 12 if they continue to study Specialist Mathematics. This calculator could be purchased for year 10 if students are confident that they will continue their studies in years 11 and 12). |
| <b>Media</b>   | 1 x 48-page A4 exercise book, 1 x USB. Students are expected to film both in and out of lesson time and to provide any extra basic costumes and props for productions.  |
| <b>Music</b>   | 1 x 96-page music exercise book (including manuscript), USB (minimum 8GB), Headphones, adapter for connecting phone to laptop, 20-page display folder.  |
