Subject Selection

The Subject Selection Process

- All Year 8 & 9 students study six subjects at any one time as well as Tuesday afternoon Sport.
- Students in Year 9 study 3 electives, students in Year 8 study 1 elective.
- In Yr. 9 half of the cohort will undertake HPE in Semester 1 and do one other of their electives whilst the other half of the cohort does two of their electives, this swaps in semester 2.

Pathways and Electives

- Year 9 electives do not necessarily lock students into a particular pathway
- e.g. you could choose Media/Drama in Yr. 10 even if it's not one of your electives in Yr. 9
- LOTE can be an exception - it is recommended that students maintain connection to this subject throughout Year 9 & 10 to support success in Year 11 & 12. Students interested in Japanese should choose this subject for two consecutive semesters.**

The process...

- Head of Department information sessions in SWT.
- Subject information emailed to parents.
- Student select from broad range of subjects.
- The viability of a subject is based on the number of students choosing that subject and staff expertise.

How to Select Subjects – Year 9 (Blue Form)

- Indicate **two** subject preferences on **each** line by putting a 1 or 2 in the preference column

Considerations

- What you are going to be studying and when.
- Your second preference needs to be something that you would be willing to study should you not get your first preference.
- Subject changes will be limited so you need to ensure you understand what the subject is about – consult subject selection book, ask questions of the HoDs
