<b>Certificate II in Business</b>	USB	
<b>Diploma of Business</b>	The Diploma of Business runs over a 12 to 18-month period with a total cost of only \$1990. (The same qualification at TAFE is currently over \$5000). Payment plans are available. Students must be aged 15 years or above, and be a current Australian or NZ Citizen.

<b>Design</b>	A4 exercise book, HB pencil with eraser, ruler. School laptop device for home work.	

<b>Building &amp; Construction Skills</b>	A4 exercise book, HB pencil with eraser. Each student will be required to wear the personal protective equipment. This can be purchased from the uniform shop. PPE consists of safety glasses and an apron. This is compulsory. Students may from time to time be required to source specific material which enhances their work. This is developed through the guidance of the classroom teacher.
<b>Engineering Skills</b>	A4 exercise book, HB pencil with eraser. Each student will be required to wear the personal protective equipment. This can be purchased from the uniform shop. PPE consists of safety glasses and an apron. This is compulsory. Students may from time to time be required to source specific material which enhances their work. This is developed through the guidance of the classroom teacher.
<b>Furnishing Skills</b>	A4 exercise book, HB pencil with eraser. Each student will be required to wear the personal protective equipment. This can be purchased from the uniform shop. PPE consists of safety glasses and an apron. This is compulsory. Students may from time to time be required to source specific material which enhances their work. This is developed through the guidance of the classroom teacher.
<b>Hospitality Practices</b>	Students require a willingness to give up own personal time for preparation of functions. Students must be prepared for the emphasis on industrial practical cookery (it is not take-home food cookery) and in most weeks will be expected to supply ingredients for practical work. Students will be expected to participate and assist in specific school functions throughout the year as a part of practical assessment. Some personal cookery equipment e.g. take-home containers, standard baking tray, cheese cake tin, carry bags, tea towels. Catering events uniform: black pants or skirt, white shirt, black bow tie.

<b>Certificate III in Fitness</b>	<b>Please note this course is delivered as a partnership arrangement with an external registered training organisation, Binnacle Training. It is a fee-paying course of approximately \$365 for the first semester of the 2-year course (inclusive of \$55.00 for First Aid Unit of Competency).</b> Once the semester has commenced the money will <b>not</b> be refunded. Please note that these fees are subject to change based on the number of students electing to do the course. Students will require the usual sports uniform, comfortable shoes and a towel.
<b>Science</b>	
<b>Biology</b>	1 x 128-page A4 exercise book, 2 packets of index cards and scientific calculator. Students will be expected to participate in biological field work during the course.
<b>Chemistry</b>	1 x 128-page A4 exercise book and scientific calculator.
<b>Physics</b>	1 x 128-page A4 exercise book, 2 packets of index cards, scientific calculator.
<b>Psychology</b>	1 x 128-page A4 exercise book and scientific calculator.

<b>Language</b>	
<b>Japanese</b>	1 x A4 binder (96 page) exercise book, 1 x document wallet, headphones or ear buds.
<b>The Arts</b>	
<b>Dance</b>	Students need to have apparel for class that allows freedom of movement. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Girls – black singlet and black leggings/tights</li> <li>• Boys – black t-shirt and black tracksuit pants</li> <li>• Black jazz shoes.</li> </ul>
<b>Drama</b>	Students will be required to provide their own costume and props for performances.
<b>Film, Television &amp; New Media</b>	1x64 page A4 exercise book and a 32GB SD Card Students will be asked to film in their own time to complete assessment tasks and may present their completed tasks at various school functions (Performing Arts Nights, Open Day etc.) Whilst equipment is supplied to all film and media students by the school, booking scheduling and requirements can impact on the student's time management and creative freedom. As such, we recommend the students look in to acquiring their own equipment.
<b>Music</b>	Large exercise book including manuscript paper, USB (at least 16GB), 20-page display folder, (for sheet music) headphones, adapter to connect phone to laptop. Students may be asked to attend various performances in their own time as part of their assessment and/or learning experiences. Students may be asked to perform at various school functions (Performing Arts Nights, Open Days, lunch time concerts etc.).
<b>Visual Art</b>	2 x 2B and 2 x HB pencils, mechanical pencils "Pacer" type are desirable for graphic exercises, eraser – soft plastic, 1 x 30cm ruler, 1 x USB, sketch books – 1 or 2 (for 2-year course) (an art diary may also be useful but is not a compulsory purchase). Protective clothing – an old shirt or large apron, computer mouse of any type.
<b>Drama in Practice</b>	Students will be required to provide their own costume and props for performances.
