Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2021, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2021 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds. Initiatives implemented include:

- Implementation of a consistent teaching and learning framework the New Art and Science of Teaching and the development of the Mt Gravatt High Curriculum Planning Process to reduce teaching and learning variability and variance in impact
- Embedding of consistent reading and writing practices across the curriculums.
- Embedding of cognitive skill development: Creative and Critical proficiency across the curriculum
- Implementation of the Cycle of Inquiry to support differentiation.
- The continued development of our Success Team consisting of an additional allocation and redeployment of key staff to build teacher capacity in differentiated teaching practices through the development of the Mt Gravatt High Curriculum Planning Process.
- Collaborative empowerment of teachers through collaborative professional growth facilitated by PLTs and the Success Team
- Extra allocation of teachers to reduce class sizes and provide extension and enrichment learning opportunities.





- Extra allocation to our Student Well Being Team of a Guidance Officer and Youth Support Officer to improve learning and well-being, connections and pathways options.
- Additional allocation of Teacher Aides to support student learning progression.
- High Achievers enrichment opportunities including: Afternoon tutorials, Reading, Information and Research Centre development, and Academic Competitions.

These initiatives produced strong performances by all students across all year levels with the following outcomes achieved.

Student Academic Performance: A to C Average Performance by all students across the curriculum was 92.9%

Year 7= 96.9%, Year8 = 94.2%, Year 9 = 88.5%, Year 10= 89.2%, Year 11 91.6%, Year 12 97.3%

Senior School Performance: Queensland Certificate of Education Attainment: 98%, ATAR 62 or better: 88%, ATAR 90 or better 33% Unit 4 A to C Performance :97.3 %

Naplan Upper Two Bands and National Minimum Standards Performance: Above the nation in all test domains.
